Admore Kandlela a gentleman of unwavering strength, boundless compassion and quiet grace. Admore departed peacefully leaving behind a legacy of love resilience and faith that touched many lives.

Born in Zvishavane on 2nd of October 1960, Admore's journey began in humble surroundings, from the dusty streets of Mpopoma where he had a passion for wire toy cars as he did his primary school at Lukhanyiso primary school where his determination and intellect shone brightly from such a tender age. He proceeded to do his secondary education at Mpopoma Secondary school where he was nicknamed 'Elucidate' due to his love for fine Literature.

His thirst for knowledge led him to Fourah Bay College Sierra Leone where he graduated with a BSC in economics and social studies with an Honours in economics in 1983 and he proceeded to get multiple qualifications like an executive masters in Responsible banking from the London school of Economics which then were the foundation of a career marked by excellence

Admore's professional life reflected his meticulous nature and dedication. He began as a research officer in the Ministry of labour and social welfare in the year 1983. In the years that followed he built his professional muscle in various organisations like Sedco, PTC, AFC and in the year 2003 he became the Chief Executive Officer at POSB till the year 2022. Colleagues have admired his sharp mind and integrity and his ability to uplift teams while his family cherished his tireless work ethic and the love he poured into every endeavour

Above all Addie's heart belonged to his family. He married his beautiful wife Kudakwashe Mushech, together they built a life anchored on Faith and devotion to our Lord and saviour Jesus Christ. Their holy matrimony blessed them with Admore Junior, who brought them immeasurable joy.

Admore was a Sabhuku of the Kandlela book under Chief Mazvihwa. He spearheaded several initiatives in his village of Origin for the betterment of his people. He served faithfully in the Christ Embassy Church hence his appointment as chairman of the building committee of a 10 000 seater mega Church. He embodied Christ's teachings through acts of service. His quiet generosity and steadfast spirit inspired all who knew him.
